

# Roller Blinds DIY install guide

Thanks for choosing Urban Blinds for your new blinds. To help you out we have created this easy to follow install guide.



Depending on your order, for each blind you would have received a set of brackets that look like the images below. These need to be screwed into the top of your window frame and held up against each side, ideally 10mm in from the front of the frame.



Single Brackets

The bracket on the left in each image is for the chain side of the blind. The bracket on the right is for the pin end of the blind.




Double Brackets

Once both brackets are in place you are ready to fit the blind. This step can be easier with 2 people.

Place the chain side of the blind up first by sliding the tongue of the bracket into the chain winder. Then move to the other side of the blind and position the blind into place. The blind should just slide into the groove and then into the hole. Once engaged you should hear a click.

This end of the blind contains a pin that can be extended or concealed by turning the wheel. Concealing the pin can help during installation if the fit is tight. Conceal the pin, move the blind into position and then turn the wheel to engage the pin into the bracket.



If the blind does not reach you can turn the wheel some more to extend the pin out even further. This is handy if there has been a slight miss measure.

If you need to take the blind down for any reason then turn the wheel to conceal the pin. You should then be able to remove the blind from the brackets.

**IMPORTANT** Please make sure the blind is not wound down lower than the drop measurement and the fabric is still wrapped around the top tube. Going beyond this will damage the blind and void warranty.



We have also supplied a child safe tensioner for the chain. Place the chain in the hook and then pull the hood down so the chain is not too

loose but also not too tight. Screw the chain tensioner into place.

Done! You can now start enjoying your new blinds.
